The names of the owners of the property at the time of Local Historic Landmark designation were not included in the Ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING CERTAIN PROPERTY AS HISTORIC PROPERTY

MHEREAS, all of the prerequisites to the adoption of this ordinance as prescribed by Chapter 160A, Article 19, Part 3B of the North Carolina General Statutes, have been met; and

MHEREAS, the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County/Kernersville Historic Properties Commission has submitted a report, which is incorporated herein by reference, and recommended in a joint public hearing that the property described below be designated as a historic property; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen finds that the property described herein is of historical, architectural, and/or cultural significance, and its preservation should be encouraged;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of Winston-Salem as follows:

 $\underline{\textbf{Section 1}}.$ The following described property is hereby designated historic property:

The Dr. John Francis Shaffner House, located at 428 South Main Street in Winston-Salem, brick smokehouse outbuilding, and Lot 48, Block 559 as shown on the Forsyth County Tax Maps.

Section 2. The waiting period provided by law shall be observed prior to demolition, alteration, remodeling or removal of the designated property.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective from and after its adoption.
