SECRETARY OF STATE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION NORTH CAROLINA OF

R & M SPORTING GOODS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, INC.

- I, the undersigned, a natural person of the age eighteen (18) years or more, do make and acknowledge these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a business corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of North Carolina, as contained in Chapter 55 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, entitled "BUSINESS CORPORATION ACT," and to that end, do hereby set forth:
- l. The name of the Corporation is: R & M Sporting Goods of South Carolina, Inc.
- 2. The period of duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.
- 3. The purpose or purposes for which the Corporation is organized are:
 - (a) To own, lease and operate one or more retail sporting goods stores, including the purchasing for sale and the selling of all manner of sporting goods equipment and related items.
 - (b) To engage in any lawful act or activity for which Corporations may be organized under Chapter 55 of the General Statutes of North Carolina.
- 4. The aggregate number of shares which the Corporation shall have authority to issue is one hundred thousand (100,000) shares of Common Stock of the par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share, all of which shall be without pre-emptive rights and cumulative voting rights, except as required by the North Carolina General Statutes.
- 5. The minimum amount of consideration to be received for its shares and for which the Corporation shall commence business is One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
- 6. The address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is 215 Executive Park Boulevard, Winston-Salem, Forsyth County, North Carolina 27103, and the initial registered agent at such address is David B. Blanco.
- 7. The number of Directors of the Corporation may be fixed by the By-Laws but shall not be less than three (3), except as permitted by North Carolina General Statutes 55-25. The number of Directors constituting the initial Board of Directors shall be two (2), and the names and addresses of the individuals who will serve as Directors until the first Meeting of Shareholders, and until their successors are elected and qualified are:
