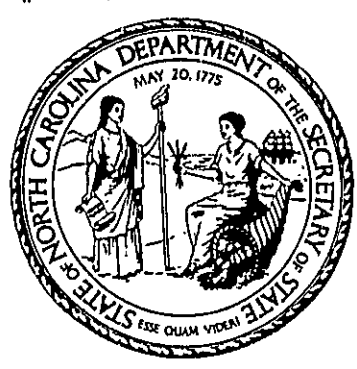

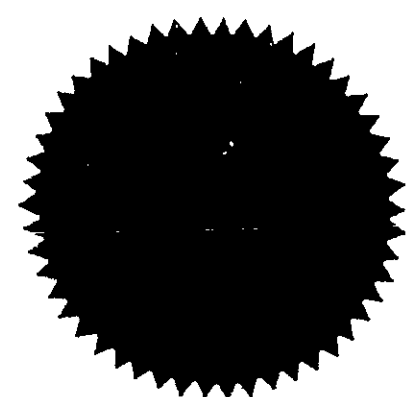

I, the undersigned, being of full age, do make and acknowledge these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a business corporation under and by virtue of the State of North Carolina.

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation shall be L AND G, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

To engage in any lawful activity for which corporations may be organized under Chapter 55 of the General Statutes of North Carolina.

ARTICLE III.

The corporation shall have authority to issue One Hundred Thousand (100,000) shares of common stock at One and No/100 Dollars (\$1.00) par value the total value of said stock not to exceed One Hundred Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$100,000.00).

ARTICLE IV.

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 102 South Cherry Street, Winston-Salem, Forsyth County, North Carolina 27101, and the initial registered agent at such address is Thomas T. Crumpler.

ARTICLE V.

The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors shall be two (2); and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the directors until the first meeting of shareholders, or until their successors be elected and qualify are:

The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.



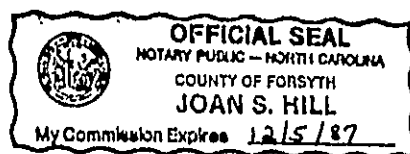


