The undersigned Affiant being first duly sworn, hereby swears or affirms that AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING CERTAIN PROPERTY AS HISTORIC PROPERTY recorded on December 30, 1982 in Book 1382, Page 376, Forsyth County Registry, by the City of Winston-Salem contained the following typographical or other minor error:

The names of the owners of the property at the time of Local Historic Landmark designation were not included in the Ordinance.

Affiant makes this Affidavit for the purpose of correcting the above-described instrument as follows:

The Forsyth County/Winston-Salem Historic Properties Commission recommended that the Charles A. Cooper Shop be designated as a historic property. The owner of the Charles A. AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING CERTAIN PROPERTY AS HISTORIC PROPERTY

WHEREAS, all of the prerequisites to the adoption of this ordinance, as prescribed by Chapter 160A, Article 19, Part 3B, of the North Carolina General Statutes, have been met; and

WHEREAS, the Forsyth County/Winston-Salem Historic Properties Commission has submitted a report, which is incorporated herein by reference, and recommended in a joint public hearing that the property described below be designated as historic property; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen finds that the property described herein are of historical, architectural, educational and/or cultural significance, and their preservation should be encouraged;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of Winston-Salem as follows:

Section 1. The following described property are hereby designated historic property:

> 1. Charles A. Cooper Shop - 419 South Main Street, Block 558, Lot 117A

Section 2. The waiting period provided by law shall be observed prior to demolition, alteration, remodeling or removal of the designated property.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective from and after its adoption.


