TRUSTEE'S DEED

THIS TRUSTEE'S DEED, Made this the 9th day of April, 1975, by LESLIE G. FRYE, Trustee, to ROY S. FULTON and wife EARSLEY N. FULTON of the County of Forsyth and State of North Carolina, WITNESSETH, That whereas J & J ASSOCIATED DEVELOPERS, INC. on the 28th day of September, 1971, made and executed to LESLIE G. FRYE Trustee, a Deed of Trust recorded in Deed of Trust Book 1079 at page 733 upon the lands hereinafter described, and whereas the said J & J ASSOCIATED DEVELOPERS, INC. failed to comply with the terms of said Deed of Trust; and whereas the said LESLIE G. FRYE Trustee in compliance with the terms of said Deed of Trust exposed said lands to public sale to the highest bidder, after due advertisement, on the 24th day of March, 1975, at the Courthouse Door in Winston-Salem, when and where ROY S. FULTON and wife EARSLEY N. FULTON became the last and highest bidders at the sum of SIXTY THREE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TEN AND NO/100 Dollars.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and the sum of SIXTY THREE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TEN AND NO/100 Dollars, in hand paid to the said LESLIE G. FRYE Trustee, by the said ROY S. FULTON and wife EARSLEY N. FULTON, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said LESLIE G. FRYE Trustee does by these presents hereby sell and convey unto the said ROY S. FULTON and wife EARSLEY N. FULTON and their successors heirs and assigns forever, the following Tract and Lot of Land lying in the County of Forsyth and State of North Carolina, and bounded as follows:
