

## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

T & D MASONRY COMPANY, INC.

The undersigned, being the age of eighteen (1900) HERMELINA or more, do hereby form a business under the Laws of North Carolina as contained in Chapter 55 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, entitled, "Business Corporation Act", and the several amendments thereto, and to that end do hereby set forth:

- The name of the corporation shall be T & D MASONRY COMPANY, INC.
  - 2. The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.
- 3. The purposes for which this corporation is organized are:
  - (a) To engage in and conduct a general masonry construction, engineering, excavating, and contracting business.
  - (b) Directly, or through ownership of shares of any corporation, to purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, manufacture, develop, sell, exchange, mortgage, create a security interest in, pledge, hypothecate, deal in and dispose of land, commodities, building materials, and other personal and real property of every kind and interest therein;
  - (c) To construct, install, remove, repair, inspect, report upon, buy, sell, handle and deal in structures and attachments thereto of all kinds, to solicit, bid for, enter into and perform contracts for the performance of construction work and the furnishing of related accessories, materials and supplies of all kinds;
