ORDINANCE DESIGNATING CERTAIN PROPERTY AS A LOCAL HISTORIC LANDMARK

WHEREAS, all of the prerequisites to the adoption of this ordinance as prescribed by Chapter 160D, Article 9, Part 4 of the North Carolina General Statutes have been met; and

WHEREAS, the Forsyth County Historic Resources Commission has submitted a report, which is incorporated herein by reference, and recommends after a separate public hearing that the property described below be designated a local historic landmark; and

WHEREAS, the City of Winston-Salem after a separate public hearing finds that the property described herein is of historical, architectural, and/or cultural significance, and the property's preservation should be encouraged, and that the qualifying elements exist as set forth in the Historic Resources Commission report:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Winston-Salem City Council as follows:

- The following described property is hereby designated a local historic landmark: Twin City Motor Company Building, 633 North Liberty Street, specifically: the complete exterior and interior of the Twin City Motor Company Building; and all of Tax Block 13, Tax Lot 240 (PIN 6835-28-2505). This property is owned by Twin City Motor Company Building, LLC.
- Section 2. The review process provided by law shall be observed prior to demolition, alteration, rehabilitation, or removal of the designated property.
- **Section 3.** This ordinance shall be effective from and after its adoption.
