- 2. INSURANCE. Grantor shall keep all improvements on said land, now existing or hereafter erected, continuously insured for the benefit of the Beneficiary against loss by fire, windstorm and such other casualties and contingencies, in such manner and in such companies for such amounts, as may be satisfactory to the Beneficiary. Grantor shall purchase such insurance, pay all premiums therefor, and shall deliver to Beneficiary such policies along with evidence of premium payment as long as the obligation secured hereby remains unpaid. If Grantor fails to purchase such insurance, pay the premiums therefor or deliver said policies along with evidence of payment of premiums thereon, then Beneficiary, at his option, may purchase such insurance. - 9. PRIOR LIENS. Default under the terms of any instrument secured by a lien to which this deed of trust is subordinate shall constitute default hereunder.
- 10. EXPENSES. Grantor agrees that all expenses paid or received by Beneficiary, including reasonable counsel fees incidental to the protection, preservation or collection of the obligation or the real estate securing the same, or the foreclosure of this Deed of Trust by suit or otherwise shall be added to or become a part of the indebtedness secured hereby and bear interest at the legal rate.
- 11. FORBEARANCE.
