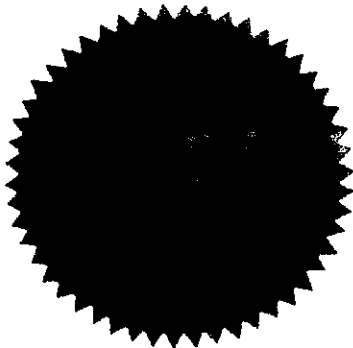

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
S & E CONSTRUCTION, INC.

The undersigned natural person of the age of 18 years or more, does hereby establish a business corporation under the laws of the State of North Carolina as contained in Chapter 55 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, entitled "Business Corporation Act", and the several amendments thereto, and to that end does hereby set forth:

1. The name of the corporation is S & E Construction, Inc.
2. The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.
3. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:
  - a. To engage in the business of general construction of residential and business properties;
  - b. To engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under Chapter 55 of the General Statutes of North Carolina.
4. The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 100,000, all of one class, having NO par value, all of which shall be without preemptive rights and cumulative voting rights except as required by the North Carolina General Statutes.
5. The minimum amount of consideration for its shares to be received by the corporation before it shall commence business is \$100.00.
6. The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 3911 University Parkway, Winston-Salem, Forsyth County, North Carolina 27106; and the name of the initial registered agent at such address is William R. DeGraw, Jr.
7. The number of directors of the corporation shall be fixed by the By-Laws, but in no event shall the number be less than the minimum required by law.

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors shall be one (1), and the name and address of the person who is to serve as director until the first meeting of shareholders or until his successor or successors are elected and qualify is:





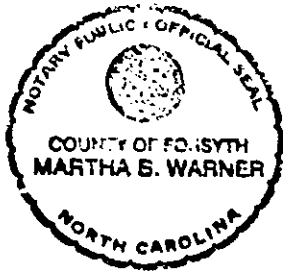
